Refugee Family Update

It has been quiet! Habakkuk 2:20 says, "But the Lord is in His holy temple; let all the earth keep silence before Him." It's an important reminder that while we wait for news. God is in control. Last Spring we reported that our refugee family was struggling financially to provide for their basic needs in Uganda. They had lost their temporary housing and had no means to secure a new place. Your generosity allowed them to move into their new apartment. It has also provided for a \$200 stipend until now that has been sent to them monthly. According to a government website, presently the average wait time to process refugee claims from Uganda is 32 months. We are now at 24 months. As we wait, please be in prayer for their safety and that they will feel God's presence. If anyone is interested in continuing to support the Mulamba family financially while they are in Uganda, please forward funds to Wendy at the church office.
