Policy Re: Financial Assistance for Educational Endeavours

Grace Church encourages students to consider formal studies in Christian education. Therefore, a financial incentive is offered as outlined in the guidelines below.

The financial incentive is based on a fund recommended to the membership at the annual meeting as a part of the church budget.

Guidelines:

1. Members of Grace who are currently attending our church are eligible to apply for financial assistance. Consideration will also be given to non-members who are actively involved at Grace. All applications are at the board's discretion.
2. Financial assistance applies to post secondary education only.
3. Applicants are eligible for \$250 per semester, up to a maximum of 4 semesters. Assistance is pro-rated for part-time students. (Full-time consists of a minimum of 4 courses per semester.)
4. Eligible schools for financial assistance include:
 - Associated Mennonite Biblical Seminary
 - Bethany Bible College
 - Briercrest/Kaleo
 - Canadian Mennonite University
 - Capenwray
 - Columbia Bible College
 - Providence & Mile II
 - Steinbach Bible College
 - YWAM

Other schools may be considered by the Missions Team for financial assistance. Required documents accompanying this application: address of school, phone #, course outline and statement of faith.

5. In processing applications, the Missions Team will give preference to first time applicants. Otherwise, it will be done on a first come/first served basis and the availability of funds. If requests exceed the budgeted amount, the Lead Team will be consulted prior to making any further commitments.
6. All requests must be accompanied by a completed application form. Applications are processed in a timely manner by the Missions Team.
7. A report will be required after the 1st term/semester before assistance is granted for the 2nd term.
