close the season in prayer. It was so neat to see these kids give Jesus the glory for bringing the team together as a family, a group of brothers, and glorifying God for how He created them.

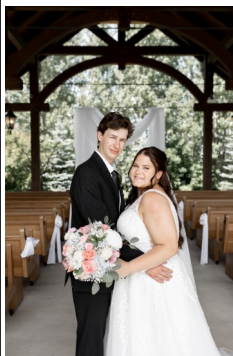

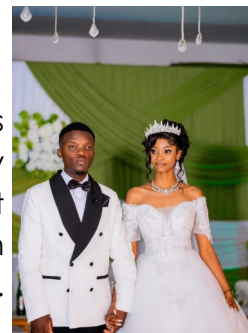

Let us know if this would be something that would interest you!

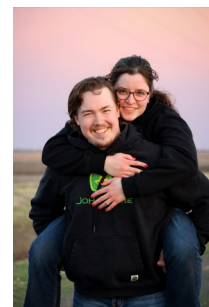
