MAF (Mission Aviation Fellowship) Update

Fuel is a critical commodity when it comes to supporting people around the world. Whether it is supplies for medical clinics, critical patient transport, or supplies and relief aid, nothing flies without fuel. Just like our gas prices have increased, so has the price in other countries around the world. Fuel prices in key countries where MAF operates have risen over 46% on average with the price almost doubling in some countries. One example comes from Angola where the price to fuel MAF's Caravan aircraft went from \$955US to \$1 684US over night. That's a 77% increase in 24 hours.

In response to this current need, Grace church has sent \$3,300 from the surplus to MAF for use where it is needed most. This is enough to fill their aircraft 2 - 3 times depending on the location. Please continue to pray for this organization, that they will have the fuel they need to provide transportation for the many missionaries and organizations they support.
